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**JACKET · LALA BERLIN FURRY**  
Design 24 from About Berlin 07

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**Size** 36/38 (40/42)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 500 (550) g of Lana Grossa **Lala Berlin Furry** (90% alpaca, 10% polyamide; 75 m/50 g) in Natural (col 1). Size 7, 8 and 12 mm needles.

**Selvage stitches:** On every row: Sl first st kwise, knit last st.

**Two-stitch selvage:** On RS row, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1. On WS row, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1, patt to last 2 sts, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif.

**Rib patt:** K1, p1.

**St st:** K on RS, p on WS.

**Garter st:** K every row.

**Gauge:** 9 sts and 12 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st on size 12 mm needles.

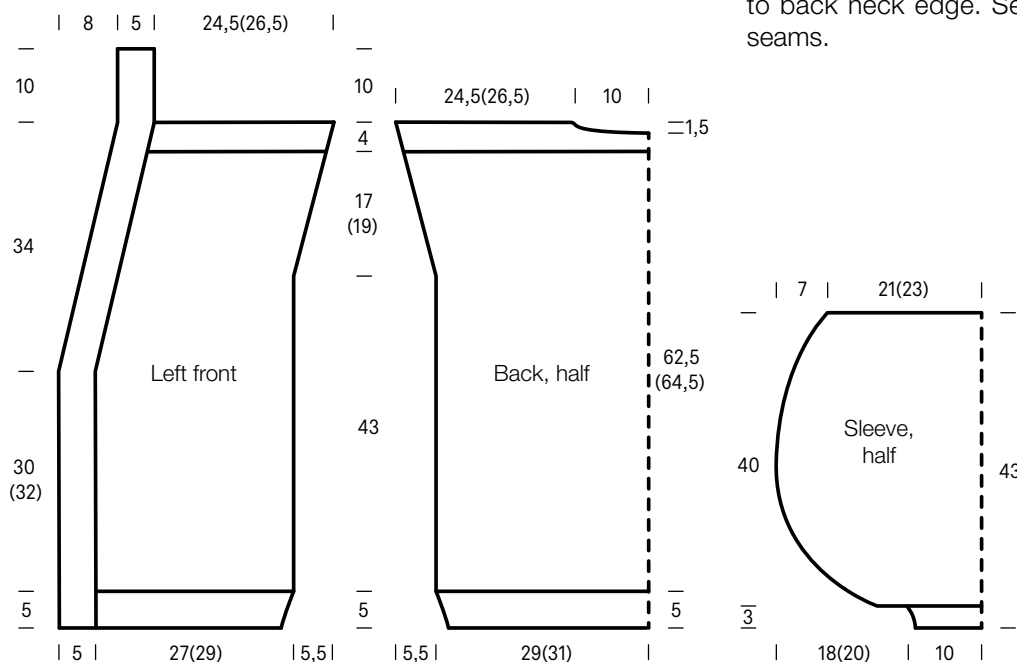
**Back:** With size 8 mm needles cast on 54 (58) sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a selvage st at each edge, work in rib patt until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on. Change to size 12 mm needles. Work in St st until piece meas 48 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Next RS (inc) row: Work in St st, inc 1 st at each end of row = 56 (60) sts. Cont in St st, rep inc row every alt RS row 4 times = 64 (68) sts. Work even until armhole meas 17 (19) cm, ending with a WS row. Work in garter st for 2.5 cm, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 18 sts. Working each side separately, work even in garter st until piece meas 1.5 cm from beg of neck shaping. Bind off rem 23 (25) sts for each shoulder.

**Left front:** With size 8 mm needles cast on 33 (35) sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, work in rib patt to last st, selvage st. Maintaining selvage sts, cont in rib patt until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 12 mm needles. Next row (RS): Selvage st, work in St st to last 7 sts, work in rib patt as established over next 5 sts, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as established until piece meas 35 (37) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next RS (dec) row: Patt to last 9 sts, skp, patt to end = 32 (34) sts. Cont in patt, rep dec row every alt RS row 7 times. **At same time,** when piece meas 48 cm from cast-on, shape armhole as foll: Next RS (inc) row: Work in patt, inc 1 st at beg of row. Cont in patt, rep inc row every alt RS row 4 times. Work even until armhole meas 17 (19) cm, ending with a WS row. Work in garter st for 4 cm, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Bind off 23 (25) sts, patt to end = 7 sts rem for neckband. Cont in patt across neckband sts for 10 cm. Bind off all sts.

**Right front:** Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement and working neck decs on RS rows as foll: Two-stitch selvage, 5 sts in rib patt, k2tog, work to end.

**Sleeves:** With size 7 mm needles cast on 20 sts. Beg and end with a WS row and working a selvage st at each edge, work in rib patt until piece meas 3 cm from cast-on. Change to size 12 mm needles. Next RS (inc) row: Work in St st, increasing 18 sts evenly across row as foll: Selvage st, k1f&b in next 18 sts, selvage st = 38 sts. Work 3 rows even. Next RS (inc) row: Selvage st, k5 (k1), k1f&b, [k1, k1f&b] 13 (17) times, knit to end = 52 (56) sts. Work even until piece meas 28 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows; [work 2 rows even, bind off 1 st at beg of next 2 rows] 3 times, then bind off 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. Loosely bind off all sts.

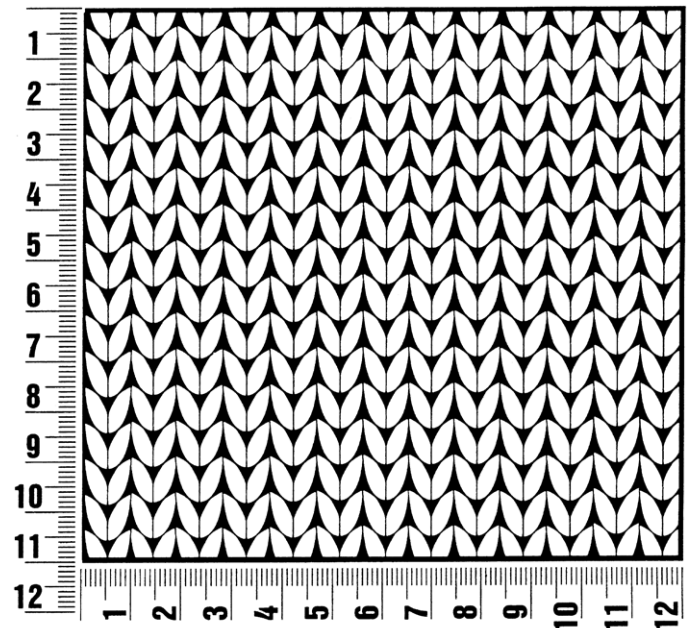
**Finishing:** Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew neckband sts tog, then sew neckband to back neck edge. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.



## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
